- **Daddy Warbucks:** wealthy, warm-hearted, stiff collared businessman--40's to 50's -- baritone
- **Annie:** spunky, sharp and full of hope. A big belter -- one of the orphans --Appears 10-11 yrs. old -- mezzo-soprano. Must be comfortable with dogs.
- **Miss Hannigan:** brazen, scheming and pessimistic. Cantankerous orphanage director -- 30's to 50's --mezzo-sop.
- **Grace Farrell:** elegant. Faithful assistant to Warbucks --late 20's to 40's -- soprano. Able to sing and move well.
- **Rooster:** dodgy and slick. Hannigan's no-good brother --20's to 30's -- baritone. Able to sing and dance well.
- **Lily St. Regis:** bubbly and dim-witted. Rooster's floozy girlfriend --20's to early 30's -- soprano. Able to dance and sing well.
- **Franklin D. Roosevelt:** President of the United States -- 50's to 60's -- baritone.
- **Orphans:** (must all be strong singers with great stage presence and move well)
